Consensus-Based Decision Making

General Information

From GCRNA Policy and Procedure

- 1. Topic is introduced.
 - All topics must be written on a topic form and given to the Facilitator (Area Chairperson) to ensure it is a valid topic.
- 2. The Facilitator opens the dialogue.
 - Begin with the maker of the topic.
- 3. Clarifying QUESTIONS are taken.
 - This is when questions are asked to ensure all participants understand the topic.
 - · This is not the time for general discussion.
- Facilitator asks for concerns or reservations.
 - This is the time when general discussion occurs.
 - This is when modifications may be made to the topic in an effort to address expressed reservations or concerns.
 - Maker of the topic and other participants may offer modifications.
- 5. Facilitator asks for consensus.
 - There are four positions a GSR may take on a topic.
 - 1. ASSENT: agree with the topic
 - 2. ASSENT w/ RESERVATION: although there are reservations or concerns, the individual will trust and go along with the body's decision
 - 3. STAND ASIDE: based in strong personal reservations which prevents support for the topic
 - BLOCK (NO): based on spiritual principles expressed in our Traditions or Concepts
 - A block must be followed by speaking to a specific Tradition of Concept which would be violated.
 - A block would prevent a topic from being adopted.
 - Consensus is reached when 80% of the GSRs are in Assent or Assent with Reservation.
 - The number which represents 80% shall be determined based on the number of GSRs present at the start of Old Business.
 - A block can be overridden by the body.
 - If the validity of the block is not questioned, the block will stand and the topic is not adopted.
 - If the validity of a block is questioned, the body must then reach consensus on whether the block should stand. The same process is used for this as for reaching consensus on a topic.
 - If the block is overridden, the facilitator will again ask for consensus on the topic.

What is CBDM?

- A way for a group of equals to make decisions. The process rests on the fundamental belief that each person has a piece of the truth, but not one person has the whole truth.
- · A solution acceptable to everyone
- An agreement on some decision by all members of a group, rather than a simple majority

How does it work for us?

- Assent: This means that the Trusted Servant supports the Topic
- Assent with Reservations: Trusted servant can support topic in spite of reservations
- Stand Aside: Trusted Servant does not support the proposal, similar to a "no" vote
- Block: Trusted Servant believes that a Traditions or Concepts are directly violated by topic

2nd Tradition

"For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority—a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern". (reprinted from Narcotics Anonymous 12 Traditions)

12 Concept

"In keeping with the spiritual nature of Narcotics Anonymous, our structure should always be one of service, never of government". (reprinted from The Twelve Concepts of NA Service)

Seventh Concept

"All members of a service body bear substantial responsibility for that body's decisions and should be allowed to fully participate in its decision-making processes". (reprinted from The Twelve Concepts of NA Service)

Ninth Concept

"All elements of our service structure have the responsibility to carefully consider all viewpoints in their decision-making processes". (reprinted from The Twelve Concepts of NA Service)

How does it work for NA?

- If we do not have 100% consensus we begin discussion to address the concerns
- Proposal may be modified during the discussion
- Test for consensus
- If after modifications and discussion there are still reservations, ask for and count Assent and Assent with Reservations
- If number does not meet set percentage (set by service body and is usually 80% to 100%) you do not have consensus
- o If number is more or equal to set percentage you have consensus

Does CBDM take longer?

- · Sometimes, but not always
- Takes practice
- · Facilitator key to process
- · Monitor time and mood of the room

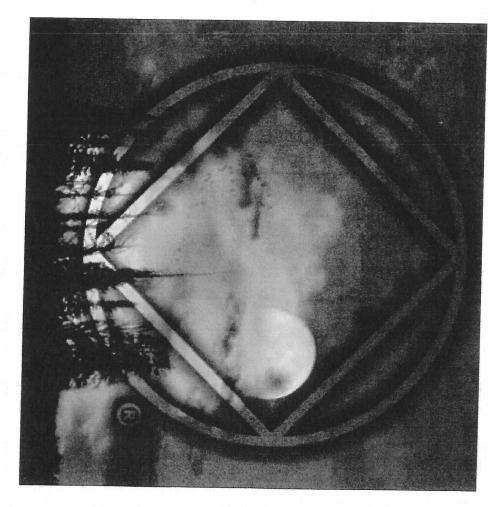
